Prof. Dr. habil. Jörg Gleiter is head of the Chair of Architectural Theory at TU Berlin's Institute of Architecture. He is the author and editor of many publications on architectural theory and a recognised expert on the history and theory of the ornament.

His PhD dissertation *The Return of the Suppressed. Critical Theory of the Ornament* (Bauhaus-Universität Weimar, 2002, in German) is a succinct summary of the ornament's theoretical history during the 20th century, while *Ornament today – digital material structural* (Bozen: Bolzano Univ. Press, 2012) addresses contemporary questions of ornamentality.

In his lecture *Ornament and the Excess of Form*, a Research Colloquium at BAU International Berlin, Prof. Gleiter will share his expertise on the history and theory of the ornament and discuss his research findings with the BAU community.
