Working field: Assistance with teaching (BA Sc., MA Sc. and M-Arch-T) and research, with the organisation of conferences and preparation of publications. The scientific interest of the department is based on the critical epistemology of architecture in the sense of architectural theory as a model of architectural thought, which is the basis of every architectural practice, albeit often unconsciously. The scientific approach is characterised by the question of linking knowledge, design, and material practice, which includes the systematisation and specification of the methodological instruments of architectural theory as a science, the question of the theory of history, as well as the critical reflection of the conceptual foundations of current architectural practice. Particular focus is placed on the semiotic, aesthetic, epistemological and scientific-theory aspects of architectural theory.

Requirements:

- Successfully completed university degree (Master, Diplom or equivalent) in the field of architecture. A focus on the fields of philosophy, the humanities, or - in special cases - the natural sciences, is desired.
- Proof of relevant experience (publications, postgraduate studies or work, cooperation in research institutes or projects, etc.) in the fields of theory and history of architecture is also desired.
- Excellent knowledge of German and English (oral as well as written), as well as good creative abilities are required.
